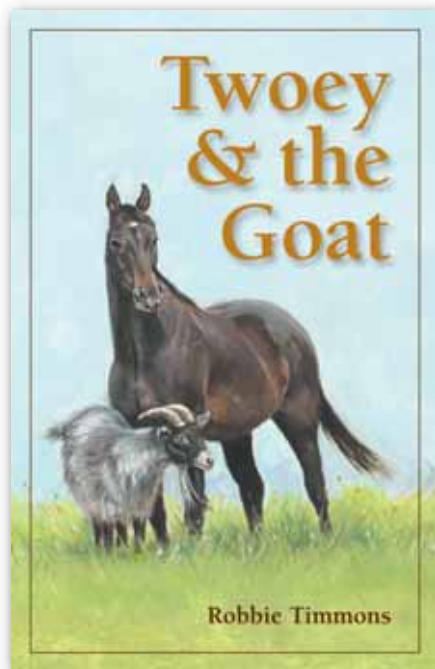

Soaking Up Carrots



Twoey and Captain Kidd just loved carrots! Here's a neat science experiment that will teach you about how carrots absorb water and nutrients. Be careful and make sure an adult helps you!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

3 carrots

sharp knife

cutting board

glass

water

red food coloring

DIRECTIONS

1. Fill a glass half full with water. Put 10 drops of the red food coloring into the water.
2. With the help of an adult, cut the end tip off of a carrot.
3. Put the carrot with end tip down in water for 4 days. Place the glass near a window where sunlight can also get to it.
4. After 4 days, take the carrot out of the water. Ask for an adult to help you cut the carrot in half, lengthwise. Inside, you will see red going up the tubes from the bottom to the top of the carrot!

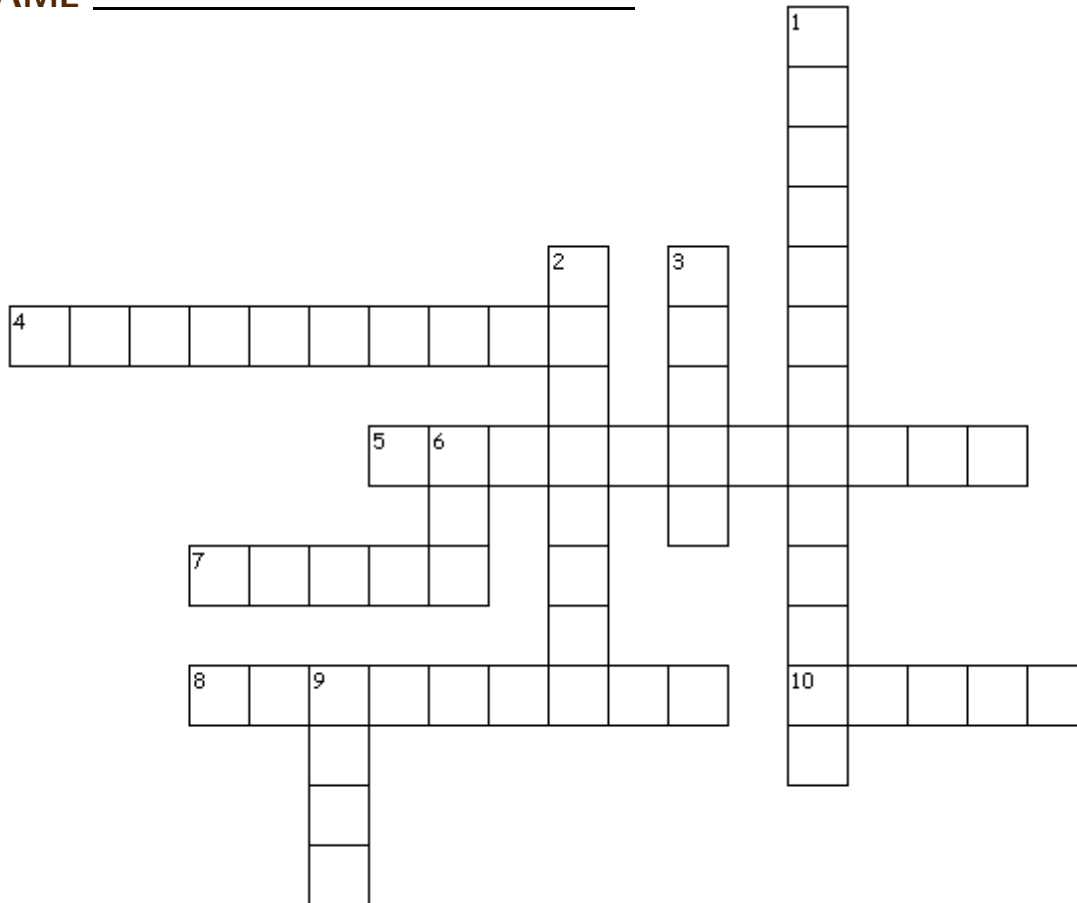
What's happening?

A carrot is a vegetable known as a taproot. This means that as a carrot grows underground, it has tubes that run through its inside. The carrot grows and receives nutrients by having water flow through these tubes. In this experiment, you are able to see this because you have dyed the water red!

Good Luck Charms



In the story, Kidd acts as a good luck charm for Twoey. This means that Twoey wouldn't perform as well in his races without Kidd as when he was there.

People around the world believe in all different kinds of good luck charms. The most commonly known is the 4-leaf clover. Supposedly, if a person finds a 4-leaf clover, they will have good luck. In this activity, you will make your very own good luck charm bookmark using a 4-leaf clover.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

A 4-leaf clover (or, if this is too hard to find, a 3-leaf clover will do)

2 pieces of paper

1 thick book

1 piece of construction paper in the color of your choice

DIRECTIONS

1. Go out to a nice big piece of grass and search for a 4-leaf clover. If this is too tricky, a 3-leaf clover will work.
2. Place the clover in between the two pieces of paper and place them in the middle of a heavy book for 3–5 days.
3. After a few days, take the clover out from between the paper.
4. Cut out a bookmark from the construction paper. Use the template on the next page if you would like! Decorate it any way you choose. Glue on the clover near the end of the bookmark.
5. It can be laminated if you want it to last longer.
